

Enrolment Process

- Contact Upper Sturt Primary School via email: dl.0448.admin@schools.sa.edu.au, by phone (08) 83392640 or by the following link: [Upper Sturt Primary School - Department for Education \(uppersturtps.sa.edu.au\)](http://uppersturtps.sa.edu.au)
- The school will send a Registration of Interest of enrolment form to fill out and return
- Book in for a School tour (held twice a term)
- In Term 3, first round offers of enrolment are sent to Upper Sturt and nearby Adelaide Hills residents and siblings of students already enrolled at Upper Sturt Primary School
- When we have received acceptance or rejection of the first round offers, the school can then send out Second round offers to students outside of the immediate area
- Enrolment packs will be sent to all enrolling families
- There are two transition half days usually held in November/December each year for students enrolling in the following year
- Children must be enrolled at school by the age of 6. This is the compulsory starting age for children in South Australia
- Most children start school from the age of 5. If your child turns 5 before the 1st May, they can start primary school at the beginning of the year

Mid-Year Intake

- From 2024, if your child turns 5 between the 1st of May and the 31st October, they can start school either:
 - The start of Term 3 of the same year
 - The start of Term 1 of the following year
- Students enrolled through a mid-year intake will complete 6 term of Reception

Your child is eligible for four terms of kindergarten before starting school.

Your child will start attending kindergarten in mid-year if you wish to enrol at school also in the mid-year intake.

It is important to co-ordinate the enrolment of both kindergarten and school if you are delaying entry to school until your child is 6.

Enrolment offers for the mid-year intake will go out in Term 1
